# MAKE EASY CLOUD DOUGH!

## YOU WILL NEED:

- 2 heaping cups of corn starch
- 1 cup conditioner (you can even use scented kind, like coconut or strawberry)
- (optional) Food coloring
- (optional) Plastic gems or beads

## INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Measure your conditioner and cornstarch and pour into your bowl. Add a few drops of food coloring if you want.
2. Use a long spatula to mix your two ingredients until it gets hard to stir.
3. Use your hands to finish kneading the dough together. You can also put it into a gallon zipper seal bag and knead it that way.
4. Now it's ready for play! What will your cloud craft be? You can even add some extra glam with plastic beads or gems, or roll it out and cut it with cookie cutters. Let your imagination soar!
5. When you're done playing, store your cloud dough in an airtight container or plastic zip bag for more fly-nomenal fun.

# HOW TO BRAID YOUR MANE

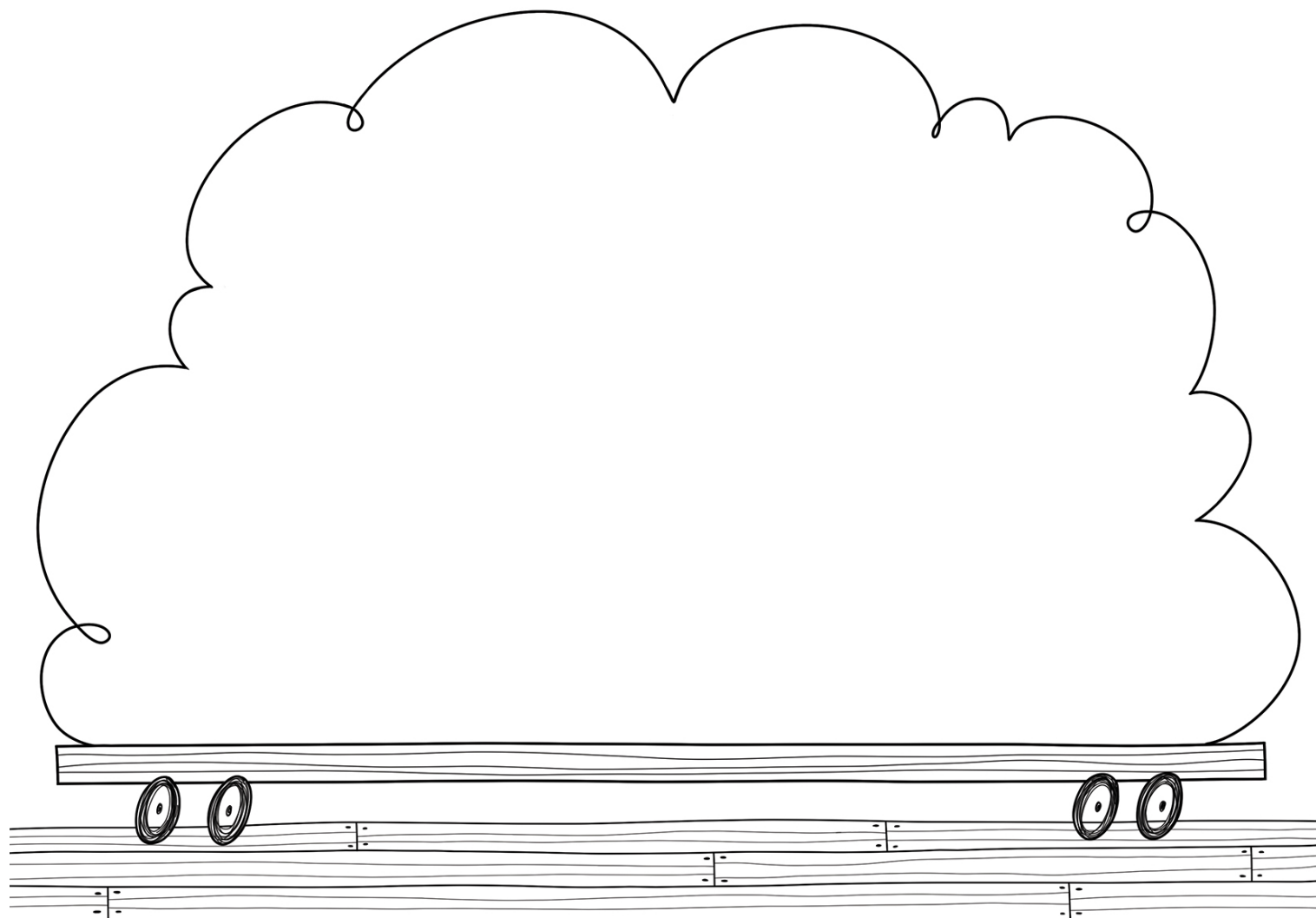
## 3 STRAND BRAID:

- 1) Start with brushed, tangle-free hair.
- 2) Divide your hair into three even sections: a right section, a middle section, and a left section.
- 3) Cross the right section over the middle section. The right section is now in the middle. What used to be the middle section is now on the right.
- 4) Cross the left section over the new middle section. The left section is now the middle section. What used to be the middle section is now on the left.
- 5) Continue the braid, alternating right and left sides. Always bring the outer section over to the middle. Alternate the right and left sides until you have a few inches of hair left.
- 6) Tie your braid off with a hair tie. Hold the end of your braid secure with one hand, and use the other hand to wrap a hair tie around the end of your braid.

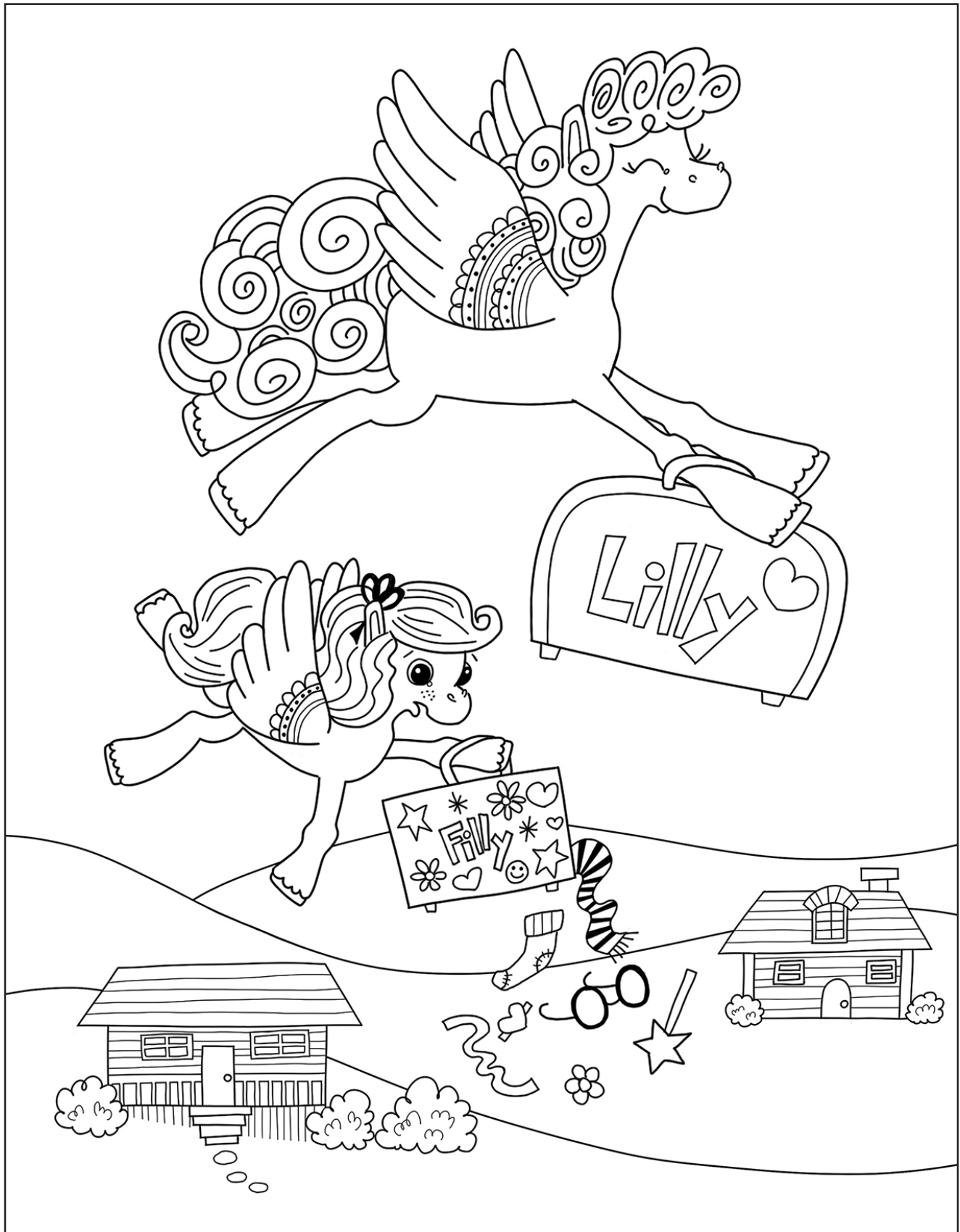

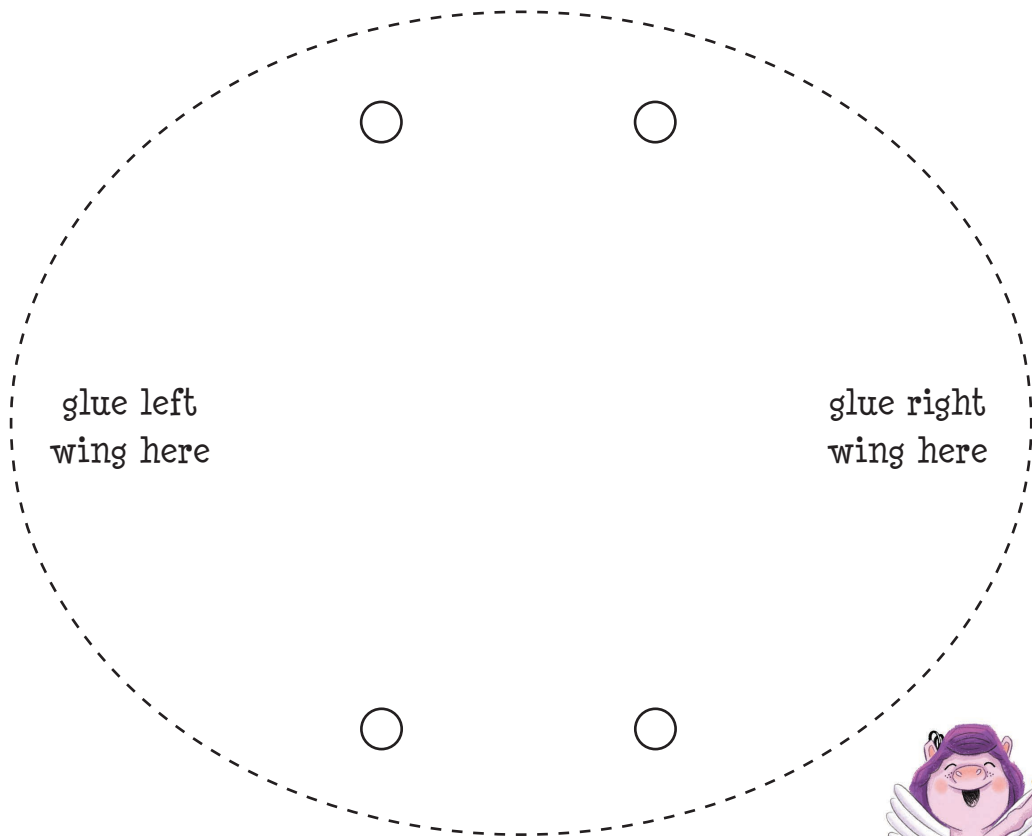

# DESIGN YOUR OWN WINGS!

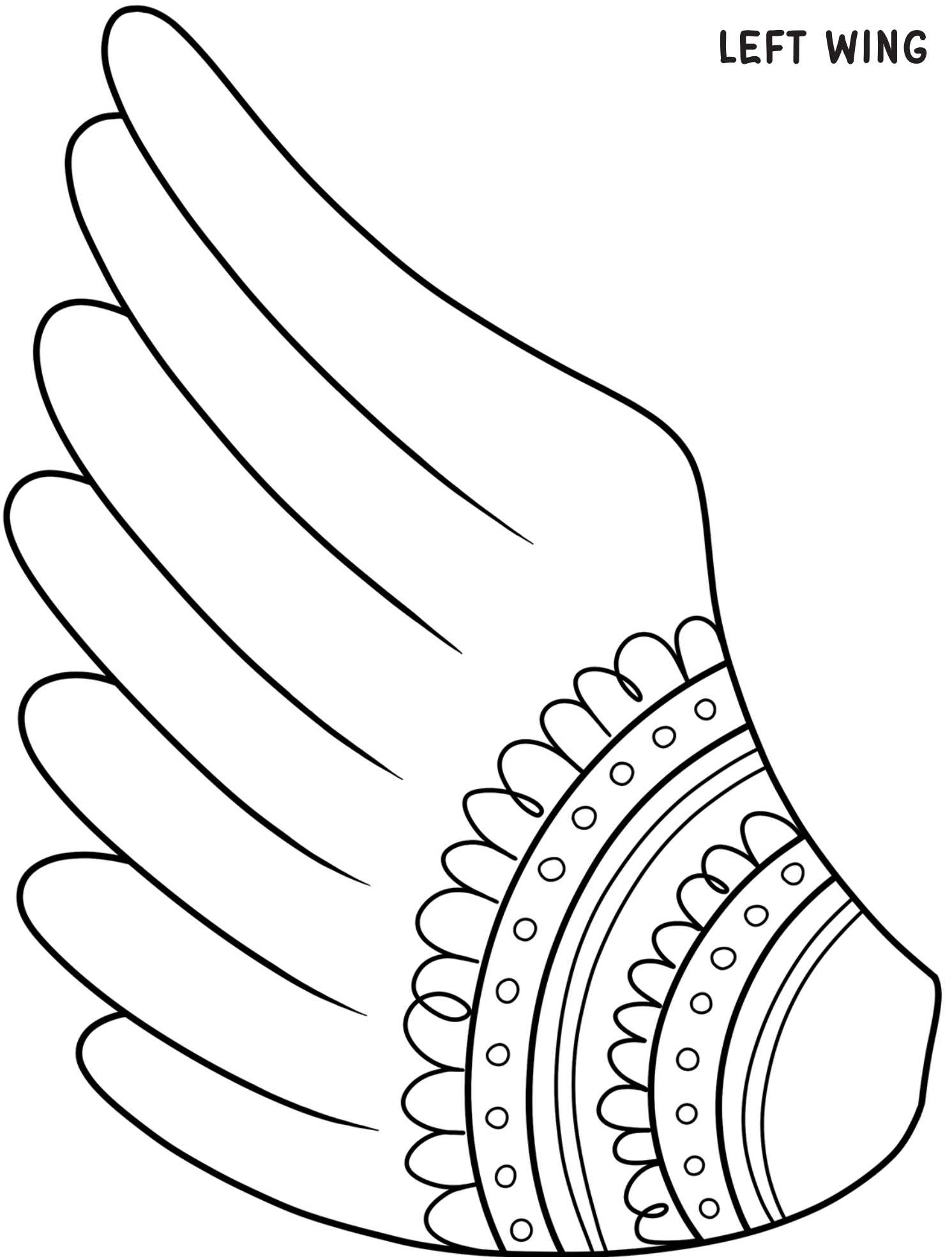
## INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1) Print out back plate and wing templates. Use heavy cardstock if available.
- 2) Color and decorate the back plate and both wings and then cut them out carefully.
- 3) Punch holes in the circles on the back plate.
- 4) Glue wings to the back plate where indicated.
- 5) Loop yarn through the holes and around arms. Tie to hold the wings in place.
- 6) Use your wings to fly!
