Blue Jaryn is a writer, illustrator and freelance editor. They write to tell the kind of stories they wished they had growing up, and they hope their writing helps kids who experience negativity for being "different." Payden's journey was inspired by Blue's own exploration of gender and what pronouns fit best. They live in Melbourne, Australia with their partner and Jack Russell terrier, Nyla. In the story, Dr. Hank **(He/Him)** is a veterinarian! Do you have a pet or a favorite animal? Can you use the lines below to describe them?






Shay (She/Her) is an acrobatic artist! Draw a rainbow in the space below:

Zoe (**Ze/Zir**) likes to dance! Let's take a few minutes to move our bodies. Can you create your own new kind of dancing?




What is your favorite song to dance to?
